1st - 6th

WORSHIP THE LORD EVERY DAY. Psalm 113:3 As we begin a new month seek to delight yourself in God. Tell him that you love him wholeheartedly, with all that you are, and all that you have. Ask him to reveal himself to you in a fresh way. Don't hurry your prayer time, but rest and soak in his presence. Let his love and goodness transform you. Ask the Father to give you a heart full of gratitude, (despite the circumstances around you) and to put a song of praise into your mind.

7th - 13th

KEEP BELIEVING IN AN ALL POWERFUL GOD. Judges Chapter 7. No thing that you face this week is too hard for your loving heavenly Father. Ask him to give you more of his strength. Ask him to give you more courage. Ask him to demonstrate his power, in your daily life. Ask him to open your eyes to see what he is doing around you. Ask him to speak to you clearly, as he did to Gideon, when Gideon prepared to go into the battle. Ask him to give you more of his wisdom.

14th - 20th

PRAY WITHOUT CEASING. Psalm 116:1+2 Remind yourself that the Creator of the Universe desires to have a friendship with you. And you don't need to book an appointment. When Jesus was on earth he got up early in the morning to talk to his Dad. Ask God to help you pray as you should. Use a notebook or a journal if that helps you to focus. Thank God for all the prayers he has answered, and ask him to show you even more answers.

21st - 27th

DO NOT GET TIRED OF DOING WHAT IS RIGHT. Gal 6:9 Try to take some time this week for a mini check-up. Ask God to show you if you are still on the right track, or re-align you to his perfect will, if necessary. Ask God to give you more energy, more patience, more commitment, more joy, more peace, more love, more understanding. Ask him specifically to assist you, in your daily routines. Ask him to produce his fruit in your life, and to make you more like his son. He knows what we need, better than we do, and his heart is turned towards his children.

28th - 31st

KEEP SHINING YOUR LIGHT IN THE DARKNESS. John 1:5 Spend the next few days thanking God for his great plan, established before the earth was formed. Thank him that he has chosen you. Thank him that Jesus has paid the price required for all our sins. Thank him that he has a good purpose planned for your life. Thank him for his perfect, unlimited love. Thank him because he is more than enough. Remind yourself that God used the apostle Peter's shadow to heal people, (Acts 5:15) and ask him to give you a merry heart so that you can deliver good medicine wherever you go.
